## WHAT IS PAWS & BOOTS?

PAWS AND BOOTS, NOW IN ITS SIXTH YEAR, WAS THE BRAIN CHILD OF FREDY CANTORAN, SERGEANT FIRST CLASS WITH THE US ARMY RECRUITING AND RETENTION COLLEGE STATIONED AT FT. KNOX.

HE WANTED A WAY FOR SOLDIERS TRAINING TO BECOME RECRUITERS TO GET INVOLVED IN THE COMMUNITY WHILE STATIONED AT FT. KNOX. HE FELT IT WAS IMPORTANT FOR THOSE SOLDIERS TO UNDERSTAND HOW CRITICAL IT WAS TO THEIR SUCCESS AS RECRUITERS BEING A PART OF A COMMUNITY ONCE THEY WERE ASSIGNED.

FREDY REACHED OUT TO THE HARDIN COUNTY ANIMAL SHELTER TO SEE IF HIS SOLDIERS COULD WALK DOGS ONCE A WEEK. THE SHELTER JUMPED AT THE CHANCE AND SINCE THAT TIME, SOLDIERS FROM THE RECRUITING AND RETENTION COLLEGE HAVE BEEN WALKING DOGS IN THE SHELTER, PLAYING WITH PUPPIES AND GIVING EXTRA TLC TO KITTENS MOST SATURDAY MORNINGS. FREDY WAS SO COMMITTED TO THIS ENDEAVOR, HE CREATED THE EMBLEM YOU SEE IN OUR PAWS AND BOOTS FACEBOOK POSTS. HIS ULTIMATE GOAL IN CREATING THIS PROGRAM AND THE EMBLEM WAS THAT A PAWS AND BOOTS SOLDIER WOULD BE SO INSPIRED BY THE PROGRAM THAT THEY WOULD START THEIR OWN WHEREVER THE OPPORTUNITY PRESENTED ITSELF.

SINCE ITS INCEPTION, PAWS AND BOOTS HAS EXPANDED TO HELP AT SPECIAL EVENTS, LIKE THE SHELTER'S RABIES AND VACCINATION CLINICS, HANDLING DOGS AT ADOPTION EVENTS AND BEING EXTRA PAIRS OF HANDS WHENEVER THE NEEDS CALLS FOR IT. AND, IN TRUE GOING-ABOVE-AND-BEYOND TRADITION, SEVERAL SOLDIERS HAVE ADOPTED A DOG AND GIVEN THEM A FUREVER HOME OVER THE YEARS. FORMER HARDIN COUNTY ANIMAL SHELTER CANINES NOW RESIDE IN CALIFORNIA, FLORIDA, VIRGINIA, TEXAS AND TENNESSEE.
